Martin County Hospital District is implementing a revised masking policy based on CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) COVID-19 Community Risk Level Assessments. The risk level will be monitored and updated weekly on Thursdays. The risk level assessments are low, medium, substantial and high. These levels are represented by the colors green for low, yellow for medium, orange for substantial and red for high.

When Martin County is at a low risk level (green), employees, visitors and patients will no longer be required to wear facemasks in any area of Martin County Hospital. However, if the risk level increases to medium (yellow) or substantial (orange), patients and visitors may be asked to wear a mask. If Martin County is at a high risk level (red), employees, visitors and patients will be required to wear facemasks at all times and in all areas of Martin County Hospital.

Regardless of the risk level, patients and visitors who have symptoms of an airborne illness, such as COVID or the flu, will be asked to wear a mask to help protect those around them.
