The Board of Directors of the Martin County Hospital District has voted to move forward with development plans for a new medical office building to be located on the campus of Martin County Hospital. The new, two-story building will be home to an enlarged Family Medical Clinic and physical/occupational/speech therapy suite. Also included will be an urgent care, outpatient treatment space, lease space for visiting physicians and shelled-in space for future growth.

“We conducted a Community Needs Assessment in late 2021 and the top priority identified by Martin County citizens was a need for increased access to both primary and specialty care within our community,” said Board President, Morgan Cox. “Our existing clinic was opened in 2012 and we have outgrown the existing space. It is difficult to add new services or providers at this time due to space limitations. Our Board hopes this new clinic will allow us to continue to provide care to a growing population for the next 10 to 15 years.”

The Board has spent the last several months developing a master site plan. The master site plan is just one component of the Hospital District’s Strategic Plan. When complete, the master site plan will include the medical office building, future expansions and renovations to Martin County Hospital and planned accommodations for other services that may be needed in the future.

“The Board is very excited regarding the direction the Hospital, Clinic, Home Health and EMS are headed. Martin County continues to grow and the Hospital District wants to be a part of that growth and development. This multi-million dollar investment will improve access to care for our citizens,” stated Mr. Cox.
